

ELISABETH BORNE UNVEILS HER ROADMAP ASKED BY PRES. MACRON UNDER TENSION

OVER PENSION REFORM DEADLINE BASTILLE DAY

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USPA NEWS - French Prime Minister, Elisabeth Borne, unveiled on April 26, a roadmap for the "next 100 days" as requested by President Macron, since the country is experiencing a general dispute, speaking in the streets since January 19 in opposition to the very unpopular pension reform. The deadline for the 100 days of action is July 14, which coincides with Bastille Day. The Prime Minister presented the seven main axes which are

- 1- Work, full employment, and the New Pact for Life at Work
- 2- The acceleration of the energy transition
- 3- Strengthening public services
- 4- The short-term replacement of teachers will take place from the 1st high school
- 5- The financing of new housing by the Caisse des Dépôts
- 6- Reinforcing Republican bite with the new "Border Force"
- 7- Recruitment of 10,000 Magistrates and Clerks

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On the question of a transversal action, ie interministerial, as requested by the President Macron, since his previous mandate from 2017 to 2022, in order to apply this beautiful expression "Equal opportunities" which has difficulty in being applied in reality... The PM replied: "Yes, this equal opportunities hold me at heart and we will continue to work in transversality and in relation with local elected officials" she replied, referring to the CNR (National Council for Refoundation), launched last December with young people on the themes of ecology, daily life, professional future, commitment and legality of opportunities. Elisabeth Borne was inspired by this: she recorded the presentation of an "action plan for young people in the coming weeks", nourished by the proposals made by the participants of these meetings. She says she is very attached to centurion of equal opportunities that she pronounced 9 times in her isérois d genette policy on July 6 at the National Assembly.

In these times of turning and social and political crisis, young people are angry alongside their parents and grandparents who march from weekend to weekend (13 Days of mobilizations with > 1 Million protesters in the street against the reform d retirement, and this since the passage in force of this law of 49.3 on March 16), this notion of equal opportunities resonates more than ever.. as the protesters are expression their anger with banging cooking sauce pans.

These numerous and squatter flash operations of pots and pan bangings are even called « The Casserolade » as these culinary ustensiles turned to become « cacophonie revolutionary symbols » agent the so unpopular pension reform and the 49,3 decree.

It all started during the Televised Address of President Macron on 17th April 2023, where LFI/ NUPES (Leftist Party) called u o for a cacophony before the city halls of many cities and districts of Paris, to make the maximum of noise, by banging kitchen tools and pans, symbolically sending the message « we cover our Presidential voice, with this noise, so that we won'e hear you either ». Since then, each Minister and the president Macron himself , are expected in the site of vis, by a bunch of angry protesters banging kitchen saucepans.

Among the major announcements, 150 police/gendarmes will soon be placed at the Italian border, to curb illegal immigration. The immigration law initially programmed for this spring will not be presented to parliament and is postponed until later, for lack of obtaining a majority (the presidential majority is not absolute) and not to "tense up the country" according to the own sayings of the PM. In terms of methodology, a new barometer of the results of public action, to monitor the progress of the various government files, will be presented to the Council of Ministers on Wednesday. This tool will then be put online on the internet in the process, under the aegis of the Minister of Transformation and the Public Service, Stanislas Guerini.

1 - WORK, FULL EMPLOYMENT THROUGH A NEW WORKING LIFE PACT

The PM, Elisabeth Borne has promised to put in place her "France Travail" bill by the end of June, the aim of which is to support RSA beneficiaries and the unemployed towards a resumption of activity.

On the side of state incentives, the PM Borne also promised to maintain the tariff shield on state energy prices, until mid-June or it will be a question of reviewing the effectiveness of the quarter. anti-inflation.

It also promises to strengthen a social agenda "for a new work life pact" while "removing the obstacles to employment" and simplifying procedures.

At the same time, the government goes on the hunt for social and tax fraud thanks to the "fraud plan" which provides for more targeted controls, with more staff of controllers and also limits tax evasion.

2 - ACCELERATE THE ENERGY TRANSITION WITH NEW FOREST MANAGEMENT

PM Elisabeth Borne, announced that the government will deploy "a new management" of forests, with a "Green Industry" bill to be presented to the National Assembly on May 15, to prevent forest fires in "organizing the clearing". "As far as cars are concerned, we will be launching a clean vehicle rental offer at affordable prices in the fall."

3 - STRENGTHENING PUBLIC SERVICES

PM Elisabeth Borne announced the "Financing of the recruitment of 6,000 additional medical assistants, by Health Insurance" by the end of 2024, in order to free up time for doctors.

New nurses will be trained (2,000 additional places are being pushed back) in nursing training institutes, to "generalize access to care services to find solutions without necessarily going through emergencies".

4- SHORT-TERM REPLACEMENT OF TEACHERS WILL BE DONE IN THE SAME HIGH SCHOOL

With regard to education, the Prime Minister has indicated that "short-term replacements will be carried out within the establishment itself" from the start of the 2023 school year. The government also wishes to generalize to primary school the sessions support in French as well as in mathematics.

5 - THE CAISSE DES DEPOTS WILL HELP THE FINANCING OF NEW HOUSING

PM Elisabeth Borne announced that the Caisse des dépôts was going to be mobilized to acquire new housing "which had difficulty finding takers".

6 - STRENGTHENING THE REPUBLICAN ORDER

PM E. Borne also detailed the new measures to ensure the safety of citizens, the government announced the opening of 200 gendarmerie brigades, as well as the establishment of a republican action force with "exceptional" means. The experimentation of a "Border Force" has also been announced and will be launched at the Italian border to fight against illegal immigration (Italy Border). An implementation must be effective within the next six months. With regard to the bill on immigration, without a majority, the government

postpones this text until the fall.

7 - RECRUITMENT OF 10,000 CLERK MAGISTRATES

PM E. Borne, promises to "simplify, modernize and reduce justice delays" and "the recruitment of 10,000 additional staff, magistrates and clerks" and added that the government will give "magistrates the ability to rely on bigger teams. A bill will be presented in June. As for freezes and cyberattacks, the PM plans as of May, "to secure and regulate digital spaces", and to prevent cyberbullying, among other things thanks to an "anti-scam" filter which will also be put in place in order to signal to users fraudulent sites.

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
